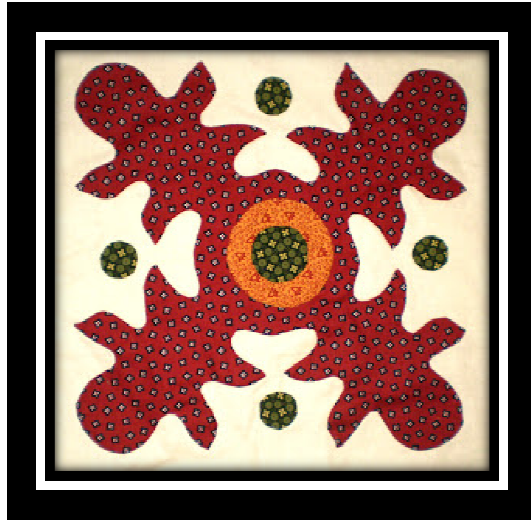


PAST REFLECTIONS



FLEUR-DE-LIS BLOCK 12

There is only one page to the printed pattern. As it is symmetrical you can just turn the sheet around and trace out the second half.

Cut your background fabric to 13" and transfer the design of the block using your favourite method.

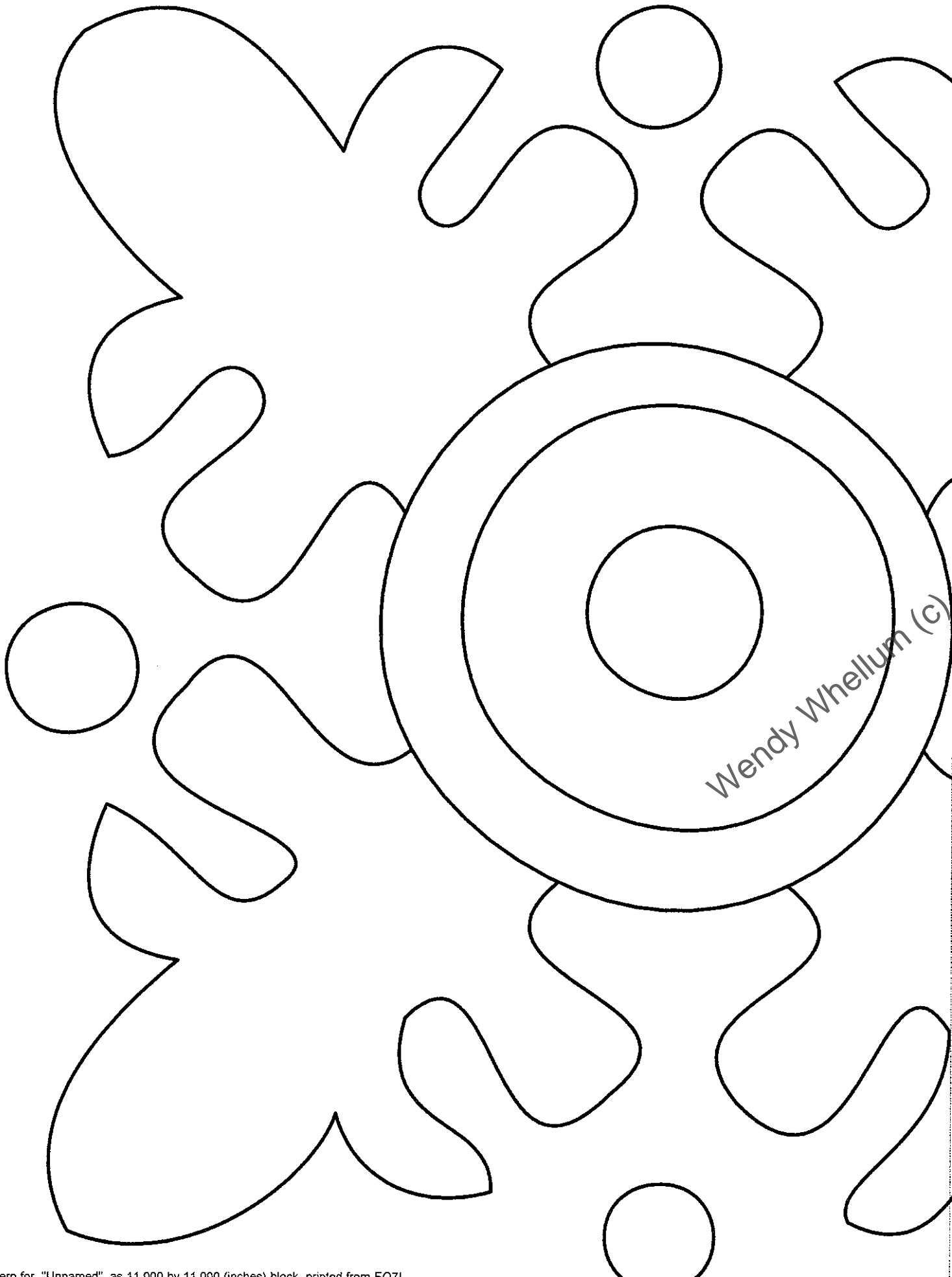
The photo of the block, and the drawing are slightly different, but the principal is the same. Start with the 4 outer leaf shapes, and applique each one in place first. Add the large circle of the same fabric over the bases of the leaf shapes. In the centre of the block you place 2 circles, one on top of the other. Between the "legs" of the leaves, finally add the 4 smaller circles.

The alternate way to complete this block, is to have the leaf shapes and the first large circle as one piece, then add the smaller circles over the top. The final effect is the same.

Once completed, spray with right side of the block with water, and press gently face down on the ironing board. Trim to 12 ½" (or the size desired).

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
