

## Past Reflections



### Corner Flower

Finished Size 12 1/2"

Cut the background fabric to 13". Join the pages of the pattern drawing along the dotted line. Transfer the design onto the background fabric using your own favourite method.

I use *Karen Kay Buckley "Perfect Circles"* to make the centre part of the block. These are made from Mylar, which is plastic that does not melt. I made the large red circle first, then put the gold one over top and cut away the back a bit, before adding the top green circles.

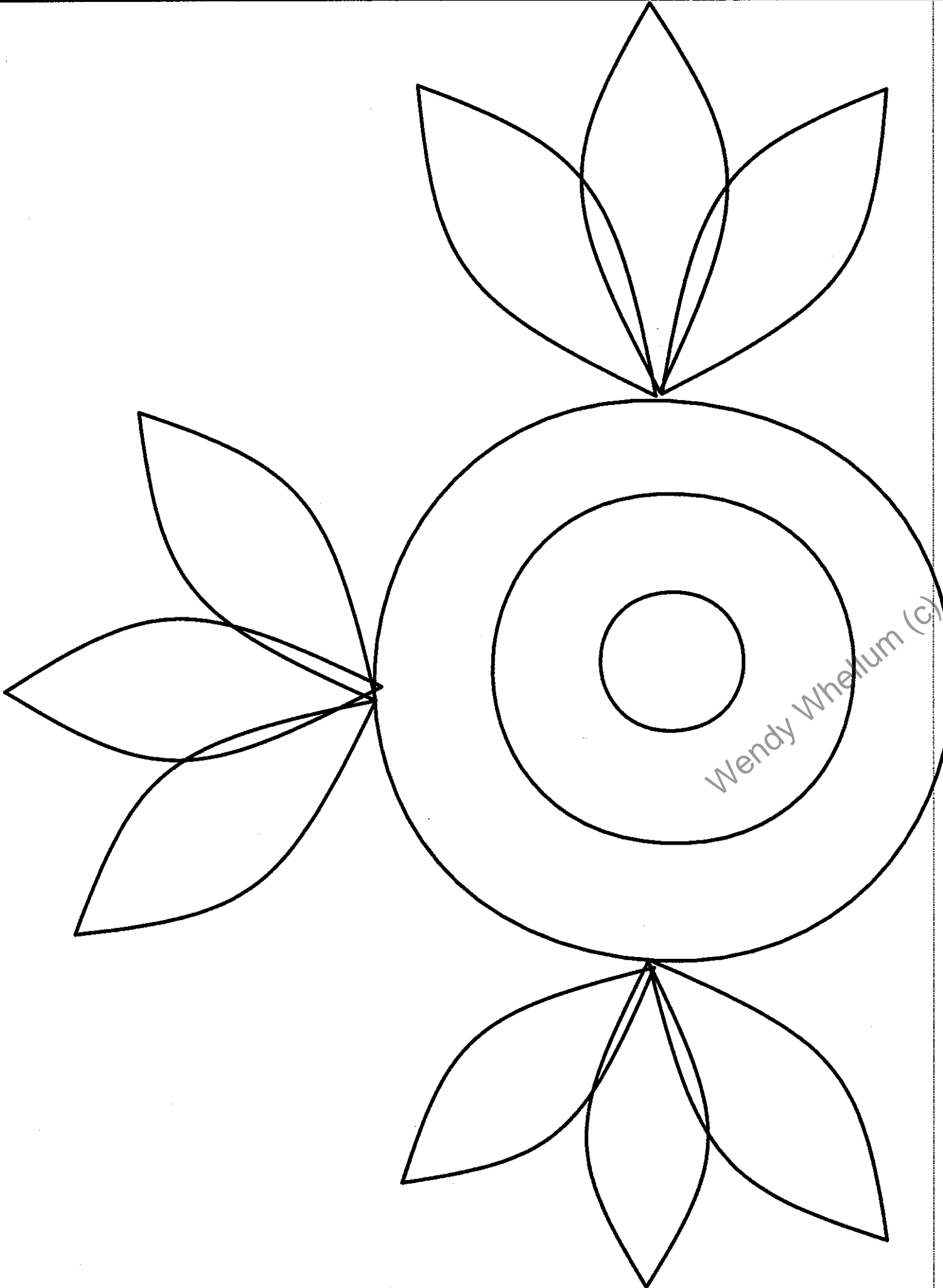
The pink flower buds in the centre of the flowers were appliqued next, then the green leaves added over the top, so that they just touch at the base, and lock into the edge of the circle.

Lightly spray the finished block with water, turn face down onto the ironing board and press gently. Your block is now complete.

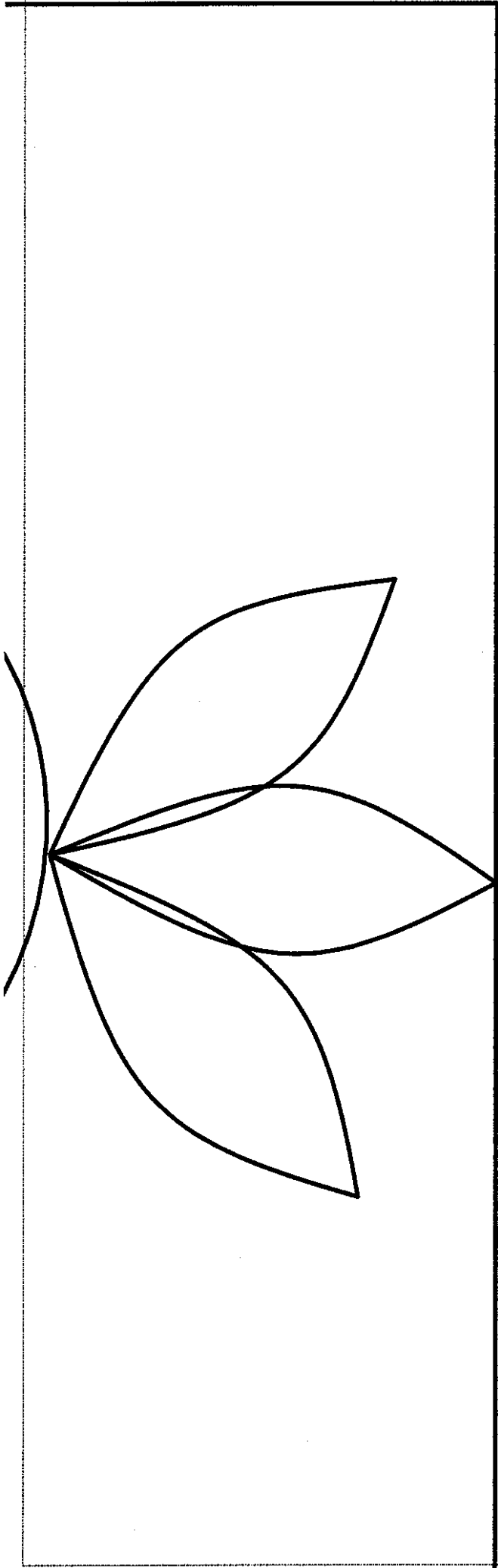
